PROGRAMS

Since 1989, Rebuilding Together Peninsula (RTP) has provided critical home safety repairs and rehabilitation work for the Peninsula's most vulnerable neighbors. As a result, we have become a trusted resource for San Mateo and northern Santa Clara counties' homeowners in need, and the leading experts in preserving affordable housing and rehabilitation.

National Rebuilding Day (NRD) is our longest-standing program. It has become a tradition led and implemented annually by volunteers on the last Saturday in April. After a year of planning, these skilled and unskilled volunteers repair dozens of homes, community facilities, and non-profit centers.

Safe at Home (SAH) provides critical health and safety-related repairs and modifications year-round, from minor plumbing and electrical work, to grab bar installation and other safety-prevention measures. Our skilled technicians and volunteers rehabilitate homes, making them healthier and safer for eligible homeowners.

Team Build offers community-minded corporations and service organizations tailored volunteer and sponsorship opportunities that primarily take place during the summer and fall.

We all know affordable housing is a major issue in the Bay Area. Rents are among the highest in the country and construction costs are among the highest in the world. The hardest hit are our neighbors living on limited or fixed incomes who need to preserve the homes they own, those caught in an ever-deepening hole of economic disparity. And as they age, they are less able to maintain their homes themselves and so depend on outside assistance—that's where Rebuilding Together Peninsula (RTP) comes in.

For thirty years we've been transforming lives by providing free home repair. Now we are the local leader in rebuilding. We have the technical expertise, decades of experience, and the extraordinary volunteer support from our community to fulfill our mission to "Repair homes, revitalize communities, and rebuild lives."

A recent survey revealed that 99% of homeowners we served felt safer in their homes after

receiving our services and 95% felt our work made a positive impact on the community.

The homeowners who turn to us represent the history and fabric of the Peninsula. Everyone, including our low-income neighbors, deserves the chance to stay in the communities they call home. Thank you for your investment in us so that together we can make that dream a reality.

THE WOLLENBERG AWARD

From stuffing envelopes to building fences, the Kiwanis Club of Palo Alto is always busy with a project. Fortunately for us, they have been active supporters of National Rebuilding Day since the 1990's putting their teams to work on our neighborhood projects.

The Kiwanis Club of Palo Alto was formed in 1925 as a service club for Palo Alto. They have a strong fundraising ethic and each year they organize several fundraising events to support local organizations. The Kiwanis Club's mission is to help children of the world. According to Kiwanis lore, one of the first projects involved raising money to buy milk for local school children.

The Palo Alto chapter engages volunteers each year to carry out their mission standing by their motto "Building strong families and communities." The motto resonates with Rebuilding Together Peninsula and our commitment to revitalizing communities and rebuilding lives. According to RTP Construction Captain, Brian Dahlquist, "RTP is right up our alley." Kiwanis members like to build things and RTP gives them the opportunity to rebuild and make a difference. "We really enjoy working with RTP because we feel the impact of our projects," says Brian.

The club has worked on several community facilities that support children. In 2017 they

co-sponsored Head Start in Menlo Park and in 2018 the club worked on the Aspire East Palo Alto Charter School. The project was a group effort, teaming up with the National Charity League and the Service League of Boys. In fact, the Kiwanis Club has been working with these two groups of young people and other service organizations, such as local rotary clubs, for the past few years. "We're usually working by ourselves on projects, but RTP gives us the opportunity to collaborate with other service organizations—that's a real plus," says RTP Volunteer Captain Marty Deggeller.

While working on an NRD project, club members will stay with it until it's completed, no matter how long it takes. As Brian explains, "If we don't finish a project, we go back and back and back. We take it seriously and make sure everything is done."

RTP is grateful for the longstanding commitment of the Kiwanis Club of Palo Alto for raising funds and providing enthusiastic volunteers for our projects. "We support organizations over and over again and RTP is one of our regulars," Brian says. "We think of the staff as our friends."

Eddie Raymond has always been a "do-er." From an early age, Eddie's parents instilled in him a solid work ethic, stressing the importance of both giving back to the community and getting things done.
