

Preferred Vendor/Subcontractor Procurement Process

Our goal is to engage the services of vendors who meet our vendor pre-qualifications, treat our clients with respect, complete quality and timely work, and give us the best and fair price. In order for this to happen, we have established the following process for vendor selection:

- 1) At the beginning of each fiscal year, we publicize our need for vendors/subcontractors specializing in Plumbing, Electrical, HVAC, Roofing, GC, Windows/Doors, Flooring and Painting by:
 - A) Placing a call for vendors ad in the Builders Exchange
 - B) Posting a call for vendors on our website and various social media platforms
 - C) Posting a call for vendors in our e-newsletters
 - D) Inviting current/previous vendors to re-apply
 - E) Encouraging minority and women owned businesses to apply
- 2) A Prequalified Contractor Application is sent to each vendor/subcontractor who responds to our call.
- 3) Once we have received their application and we determine they meet the requirements, we invite relevant vendors/subcontractors to bid on relevant projects. It is our hope to receive at least 2 bids per category.
- 4) We then review bids to determine which vendor/subcontractor best meets our goals mentioned above.
- 5) The vendors/subcontractors who best meet our goals become our Preferred Vendors for the year.

When we are unable to obtain enough prequalified vendors/subcontractors, we will continue to solicit interest, with the hopes of recruiting more throughout the year. In this case, we will continue to engage the services of the Preferred Vendors that we have previously vetted.

At any time during the year, interested vendors can also approach us and complete the Prequalified Contractor Application and can bid on a job. We will evaluate their bid in the same way we do our existing vendors on an annual basis.

RTP adheres to full and open competitive bidding as outlined in <u>HUD Regulation 2CFR 200.319(e)</u>. Vendors working in conjunction with RTP, but hiring their own subcontractor, must likewise adhere to this regulation.

Preferred Vendor / Subcontractor Selection Overview

General Overview: Rebuilding Together Peninsula (RTP) is a non-profit organization that performs critical home repairs throughout San Mateo County and parts of northern Santa Clara County at no cost to qualifying homeowners. Operating since 1989, RTP's and its volunteer partnerships' work in rehabilitating homes and community facilities for our neighbors – often seniors, people with disabilities, etc. - allows them to live more independently in warmth and safety.

Vendor Criteria Rating: RTP monitors the following throughout the year to identify vendors that demonstrate:

- Understanding of RTP Mission & Goals We are a non-profit that primarily serves elderly and disabled homeowners through home repairs at no cost to our clients. We expect the vendors with whom we contract (and their employees) to understand our mission in order to best respond to and serve our clients.
- Competitive Pricing As responsible stewards of all funds we receive, we closely monitor our sub-contracted projects for competitive pricing. Discounts and any donated materials/labor are tax- deductible to the full extent of the law.
- Quality of Work/Service RTP has provided free home repair services to our clients since 1989. Our greatest tool in outreach is client word-of-mouth. Among the communities we serve, the quality of our work, and, therefore, our credibility is key for our continued success. We continually monitor our vendor relationships to ensure that our reputation remains in high regard.
- Customer Service As a subcontractor, you represent our organization. We expect that your technicians/staff that interact with our clients adhere to a high quality of customer service.
- Communication –We encourage and expect open and timely communication from our vendors. In addition, we expect that your technicians/staff who interact with our clients follow a mutually agreed upon communication protocol.
- Timing Due to the nature of sub-contracted repairs, timing is very important to our program. A mutually agreed upon repair response timeline is established prior to engagement with a vendor.

- Free and prompt estimates
- In-house technicians (versus subcontracting)
- No upselling
- Multilingual support (Spanish/Mandarin/Cantonese/Fijian/Tongan/Samoan)
- Engagement in RTP volunteerism
- RRP Certification (as appropriate)
- Mobile Home Experience

Preferred Vendor Requirements

- Valid Contractor/Business License and Better Business Bureau record in good standing
- Valid General Liability and Workers Comp insurance
- Net 30 payment terms
- Vendor must adhere to local/state code requirements, and pull permits as required
- Vendor must provide written documentation (receipts, invoices, etc.) for reimbursement

Women and minority-owned businesses are encouraged to apply.
